Saving Grace Starts Free Mobile Pet Food Bank

Roseburg, OR, September 14th, 2020: Beginning Wednesday, September 16th, Saving Grace will host a free pet food distribution for anyone in need on the first Saturday and third Wednesday of each month. The distribution will take place from noon to 2pm at Stewart Park in Roseburg.

“No one should have to choose between feeding themselves and feeding their pets. Saving Grace has more than enough pet food to share thanks to a generous donation from Science Diet and donations from our community. We are really excited to start this new program,” says Executive Director Megan Gram.



There is no requirement to show proof of need; pet owners simply need to show up during the hours of noon to 2pm at Stewart Park in Roseburg (we will be parked near the train tracks) to receive food. We cannot guarantee the type of food we will have to distribute, and we have a limited supply of food to distribute each week, so it is a good idea to arrive early. If you have an urgent need for food, please come directly to the shelter Mon-Sat. between 10am and 4pm so we can help.

This program is designed to help keep pets happy, healthy and most importantly, in their homes with their families. “We hope to implement more programs like this one in the future. There is no reason for an animal who is loved to become homeless because of something as simple as not having enough food or access to basic medical care. If we can start to bridge that gap we will be able to keep more pets in their homes where they belong,” says Gram.
